The City of Cibolo organization is continually working to enhance the quality of life for our citizenry. The city is growing in accordance with its master plan.

Statistics indicate Cibolo's population is expected to increase by approximately 21% over the next five years. That equates to about 6,700 additional people sharing the roadways, parks, water system, and emergency services in our community.

The wear and tear on infrastructure and increased service requests from population growth requires resources to support the needs of the community.

The City strives to find the right balance in the budget to meet the needs of the community while remaining focused on fiscal responsibility to the taxpayers.
