

Cibolo Economic Development Corporation Policy Regarding the Classification of Businesses on the Cibolo Business Directory.

At the August 20, 2020, Economic Development Corporation Board Meeting, the Board of Directors approved the following policy regarding the definition of a Cibolo businesses to be added to the Cibolo Business Directory.

Brick-and-mortar businesses: All businesses with a physical presence in a commercial/industrial building within the City of Cibolo city limits are added to the Cibolo Business Directory when they open for business. The business representative contact information is added to Constant Contact for email updates from the City and CEDC.

Home-based businesses, Multi-level marketing businesses, and Direct sales businesses: Staff adds the business to the Cibolo Business Directory if a City Home Occupation Affidavit is completed. Home-based businesses must have incorporation documents submitted to the State of Texas with an address within the City of Cibolo city limits. The business representative contact information is added to Constant Contact for email updates from the City and CEDC.

Food trucks: Staff adds the business to the Cibolo Business Directory if the food truck operates at least 51% of the time within the City of Cibolo city limits, including those from the surrounding area, OR the food truck's incorporation documents with the State of Texas have an address within the City of Cibolo city limits. The business representative contact information is added to Constant Contact for email updates from the City and CEDC.

Storage units as businesses: The EDC does not consider storage units that are solely for the purpose of storing products to constitute a Cibolo business. The business is not added to the Cibolo Business Directory or Constant Contact.
