



RESOLUTION NO. 1630

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THAT THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF CIBOLO, TEXAS PASSED AND APPROVED A PROPOSITION FOR THE SALE AND CONVEYANCE OF 5.6 ACRES OUT OF NIEMIETZ PARK IN THE CITY OF CIBOLO, GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS AT THE ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022.

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2022, the City Council (the *Council*) of the City of Cibolo, Texas (the *City*) ordered an election to be held on November 8, 2022, for the purpose of determining whether the resident, qualified voters of the City would authorize the sale and conveyance of 5.6 acres out of Niemietz Park in the City of Cibolo, Guadalupe County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to this election, including the resolving, notices, election officers, holding, and returns thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby canvasses the returns of the election, at which there were submitted to all resident, qualified voters of the City for their action thereupon, the following proposition:

“Shall the City of Cibolo be authorized to sell or exchange 5.6 acres city-owned land out of Niemietz Park located at 618 FM 78, Cibolo, Texas in exchange for 5.6 acres of land owned by the Cibolo Economic Development Corporation for purposes of economic development and revitalization of Niemietz Park?”
